Pula: Botswana Journal of African Studies (also known as *Pula*) is an interdisciplinary devoted to the studies of issues affecting the African continent, especially Southern Africa. It therefore publishes peer reviewed scholarly articles on politics, education, the economy, language policy and language planning, linguistics, literature, theatre, gender, tourism, health, the environment, the media ...the list goes on.

The journal's editorial board consists of highly qualified scholars and experts in their own areas of research. The journal is busy recruiting additional editors from around the world and to constitute an advisory board in line with international best practice. The objectives of the journal are to provide a platform for researchers at the University of Botswana and from the sub-continent to publish their research findings and contribute to research excellence, in line with the broader objectives of the University of Botswana to become research intensive and achieve academic visibility worldwide.

Pula is published twice per annum with the first issue of the journal coming out in August and the second issue in December of each year. It takes between twelve and eighteen months for a paper to be submitted, reviewed, accepted and published. So authors need to plan ahead and submit articles timely to ensure their articles are published on time. However, the publication of articles may take longer if there is an overwhelming number of submissions, or if there has been a special issue which may interfere with the publication of regular issues. If this happens, the authors are informed accordingly.
